




INTERNATIONAL IMMERSION TOURS

COURSE STRUCTURE



Our MBA program will test initiative, inspire resourcefulness, challenge creativity and demand your intellectual and emotional intelligence. Here's an overview of the program structure and the three different study options available to suit your lifestyle.

ACCELERATED

Our MBA can be completed in **12 months** full-time and is taught in intensive blocks between early January and November. International students are only able to complete the accelerated option.

STREAMLINED

The UQ Business School MBA program can be finished in **24 months** alongside your work commitments and is structured to include some evening classes, weekend intensive classes and some one-week intensive mode offerings.

FLEXIBLE

To flexibly complete your MBA due to work or personal commitments, you can structure the program to suit your needs by taking evening, weekend or one-week intensive classes.

ADMISSION

Applicants for our MBA program must have **four years full-time work experience** post-graduation including **at least two of the four years in a dedicated management role** as well as a:

- Bachelor degree or equivalent with a GPA of at least 4.50 on a 7-point scale
- OR Graduate Diploma in Business Administration from UQ or equivalent with a GPA of at least 4.50 on a 7-point scale
- International applicants must complete the Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) with a minimum score of 550 and achieve at least 6.5 overall in the IELTS test (or equivalent test)*
- Applicants without a completed degree can apply on the basis of significant work and management experience.*
